

737th Session
Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors
February 4, 2014

The scheduled meeting of February 4, 2014 was held at the Board Office, 165 Capitol Avenue, Room 117 in the State Office Building, Hartford, Connecticut.

Anthony L D'Andrea, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:20 am.

Attending the meeting were: John DeWolf (1) PE, Richard M Szewczak (2) PE, Anthony L D'Andrea (4) PELS Robert L Doane (5) PELS, AL Regina (7)PM and Rocco V Laraia (8) PM.

Kenneth R Peterson (10) LS, Curtiss B Smith (11) LS and Raymond Redniss (12) LS were excused from the meeting by Chairman D'Andrea due to lack of land surveying business on the agenda.

Absent were: Terry McCarthy (3) PE, Donald J Poland (6) PM and T. Mark Barbieri (9) PM.

Also present were: Peter Huntsman, Assist Attorney General, Steven Schwane, Attorney for the Department of Consumer Protection and Barbara Syp-Maziarz, Board Administrator.

Motion made by (7) seconded by (8) to approve the January 14, 2014 minutes as amended. Motion carried.

Legal Division-

Attorney Schwane advised the Board that the proposed regulations is still being reviewed by the Department.

Assistant Attorney General Peter Huntsman - Issue of Mark Benson who once held a license in CT, wants to be considered as a new applicant and not be considered as a reinstatement. The Board held a discussion to 21a-4 (d) which discusses the reinstatement procedures.

The Board asked Attorney Huntsman to summarize 21a-4 (d) which states that each applicant whose license has lapsed for a period longer than the length of time allowing automatic reinstatement, may apply for reinstatement with the appropriate board upon receipt of such application and payment of the fee accompanied by a notarized letter , and the applicant shall pay all back license and late fees in order for such license to be reinstated. The Board also asked for a summary to Public Act 13-216 which allows a professional engineer who is not residing or engaging in professional engineering in

Connecticut to surrender their license in Connecticut and then when they return only pay the current fee.

The Board is seeking advice from the attorney general's office in regards to the legislative history of 21a-4 (d) and Public Act 13-216.

Attorney Huntsman stated that he should have information at the next meeting.
