PA 13-284 SB 1067	AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAL SPA FACILITIES This bill would have taken effect on October 1, 2013. The Governor vetoed the bill. Read Veto Message.
PA 13-309 HB 6658	AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYER USE OF NONCOMPETE AGREEMENTS This bill would have taken effect on October 1, 2013. The Governor vetoed the bill. Read Veto Message.

As of this date, the Governor has signed three hundred and twenty seven (327) bills and vetoed eight (8) bills of the 2013 Legislative Session.
