HB 5348 AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSIDERATION OF PROPERTY VALUES WHEN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR A CERTAIN PROPERTY TAX RELIEF PROGRAM.  
This bill would have taken effect October 1, 2014. The Governor vetoed the bill. [Read Veto Message](#).
- PA 14-125  
HB 5220 AN ACT CONCERNING A PROPERTY OWNER'S LIABILITY FOR THE EXPENSES OF REMOVING A FALLEN TREE OR LIMB.  
This bill would have taken effect October 1, 2014. The Governor vetoed the bill. [Read Veto Message](#).

As of this date, the Governor has signed one hundred and sixty five (165) bills and vetoed four (4) bills of the 2014 Legislative Session.
