**Re.: Executive Order 37 - Review of Agency Regulations
Department of Administrative Services**

Dear Governor Malloy,

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) has undertaken the work that you directed pursuant to Executive Order 37, issued in October 2013. Specifically, we have analyzed all existing agency regulations that are over four years old, as well as the public comments received by your office relating to agency regulations, to determine whether any of our regulations are outdated, unnecessarily burdensome, insufficient or ineffective.

You have asked that we provide you with a report by February 3, 2014 that summarizes comments received from the public; provides recommendations regarding the elimination or modification of any regulation deemed outdated, unnecessarily burdensome, insufficient or ineffective; and offers a plan for implementing such recommendations. Our office has collaborated with your Legal Counsel's Office to develop a template chart to provide you with the information that you seek in the report. Attached please find DAS's report.

As detailed in the attached chart, DAS has identified 22 sets of regulations (or portions of regulations) that we believe can be immediately repealed as unnecessary or outdated. These regulations are highlighted in yellow in the attached

report. Additionally, we have identified many other regulations under DAS's authority that are in need of updating and/or improvement. DAS plans to prioritize the work identified in the report and work toward repeal and modification of the regulations as necessary.

I have previously designated Andrea Keilty as DAS's Officer of Regulatory Affairs for purposes of Executive Order 37. Please do not hesitate to contact me or Andrea if you have any questions about or would like to discuss the attached.
