Pursuant to Governor Dannel P. Malloy's Executive Order No. 37, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) hereby submits the attached Report, which enumerates the regulations under PURA's jurisdiction that have been identified as outdated, unnecessarily burdensome, insufficient or ineffective.

After the public comment period ended on December 16, 2013, PURA also issued a Solicitation of Further Comments on PURA Regulations, providing an additional opportunity for persons familiar with PURA's proceedings, and stakeholders in the electric, gas, water or telecommunication industries to submit comments to PURA with suggestions concerning PURA regulations. PURA has incorporated the responses received.

In preparing this Report, PURA conducted a review of all its regulations (Title 16 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies) and analyzed all public comments forwarded from the Governor's Office and from PURA's Solicitation. PURA plans to begin the process to amend the identified regulations as soon as practicable.
